



Live-Aboard Lite Halloween Overnight Costume Guidelines

General

- Costumes must be family-friendly and may not be obstructive, offensive, objectionable, or violent.
- Costumes may not contain any weapons that resemble or could easily be mistaken for an actual weapon.
- Costumes may not include items or props that must be carried, since both hands are needed to maneuver the ladders between decks.
- Costumes may not contain sharp objects, pointed objects, or materials that may accidentally strike another guest.
- Layered costumes or costume props that surround the entire body are prohibited
- Costumes may not reach or drag on the ground.
- No masks allowed. Masks of any kind can restrict sight.
- Themed T-shirts, blouses, sweatshirts, and hats are acceptable.
- Prohibited accessories include: wings, plastic light sabers, toy swords, or other props that extend off the guest or must be carried
- Headwear may be worn as long as it does not cover the face.
- Masks of any kind may not be worn.
- Guests who do not adhere to these guidelines may be refused entry into, and/or removed from the event, unless his or her costume can easily be modified to meet the above standards.

Inappropriate Attire

Attire that is not appropriate for the USS Hornet Sea, Air, & Space Museum (and which may result in refusal of admittance or ejection) includes but is not limited to:

- Clothing with objectionable material, including obscene language or graphics
- Excessively torn or loose fitting clothing which may drag on the ground and create a potential trip hazard
- Clothing which, by nature, exposes excessive portions of the skin that may be viewed as inappropriate for a family environment
- Bare feet
