We are only about half way over to Hawaii now. I expect to arrive on Tuesday the 10th. Will have plenty of mail for you and Dad and will expect lots of mail to be there for me to answer to you two.

I'm looking forward to the box that you said that you would send to me. Sorry that I didn't get the Mother's Day card sent but I just forgot all about it after I talked to you and Dad. It sure made me feel lots better to talk to you folks and Aunt Belle and Uncle Jack. I don't think that Aunt Belle cried this time as she didn't sound like it over the telephone. I'm certainly glad that she didn't as I guess I would have filled up also... Ha Ha.

I'm enjoying the trip so get busy with the mail and I'll keep it coming from this end of the ocean. Nothing much to say at present time but I sure could go on for hours at a time. I haven't eaten noon chow yet, but will do so in about five or ten minutes. I hope you and Dad are in good health and taking it easy. Hope that Dad has been lively as far as the fishing goes. Hope he catches some nice ones to take a few pictures of them so that I can see for real. Ha Ha. I'll send a slide that Burwell shot of me and it's without a smile so you'll have to excuse me as I must have been thinking?

Ha. Ha., me thinking. Some joke isn't it? I don't think so as I can at times. Of course, some of the people I know wouldn't give you credit on anything even if you deserved it one way or another.

I'm going to start on my plane this evening if I can get the Ektachrome done up. Going to mix the chemicals this afternoon and then do it tonight. Well, I have more time to write than you and Dad has. I hope you and Dad just keep up the writing. I'll be sure and answer the letters that you two write.

I got two rolls of Ektachrome done last night and one roll of B & W this evening. I'm not going to write much more. Feel fine and arrive in Pearl in the morning. Hope you are well and taking good care of each other. So long for now. Please don't get mad at the short letter as I have to mail it before ten tonight. This was started a day or so ago.
